First Tee - Greater Pasadena is a successful junior golf program that not only teaches children the game of golf, but more importantly, life skills. What sets First Tee - Greater Pasadena apart from other successful junior golf programs is the First Tee Life Skills curriculum. Through life skills education, participants learn valuable lessons about the importance of maintaining a positive attitude; how to make decisions by thinking about the possible consequences; how to define and set goals; and how to transfer values such as responsibility, honesty, integrity, respect, confidence, perseverance, courtesy, judgment and sportsmanship from golf to everyday life. These lessons for life are taught through a variety of golf-related exercises designed with the primary goal of having fun.

Since its inception in 2006, First Tee - Greater Pasadena has served over 211,000 youth in the Greater Pasadena area in our Life Skills Certification programs at green grass facilities, TARGET Outreach Programs, National Schools Programs NSP, and DRIVE programs.

Life Skills curriculum classes

- Serving 850 life-skills participants per year

From 2006-2019, First Tee - Greater Pasadena has introduced the First Tee Life Skills Curriculum to over 2,182 youth in the Greater Pasadena area. These youth are exposed to the game of golf at a green grass facility (golf course). First Tee - Greater Pasadena's home facility is Brookside Golf Club. Additional programming is provided at these affiliate locations: Alhambra Golf Course, Altadena Golf Course, Arroyo Seco Golf Course, Diamond Bar Golf Course, Eaton Canyon Golf Course, Marshall Canyon Golf Course, and Scholl Canyon Golf Course.

First Tee - Greater Pasadena offers four eight-week seasonal sessions annually. Session fees are \$100 per student. First Tee - Greater Pasadena offers scholarships for students who are unable to pay the registration fee. The average cost incurred by First Tee - Greater Pasadena is \$150 per student per session. The following are examples of the classes and programs that First Tee - Greater Pasadena provides at various golf courses throughout the Greater Pasadena area.

First Tee Life Skills Curriculum Levels

Outreach programs

First Tee - Greater Pasadena provides the Greater Pasadena area with three outreach programs. These outreach programs, introduce the game of golf using SNAG equipment during physical education classes, on playgrounds, and in parks. After this, the youth are presented the opportunity to learn more through First Tee - Greater Pasadena classes, at our green grass facilities:

TARGET Outreach Programs

- Youth receive an overview of the game and how it's played, basic skills introduction and an introduction to the positive values and life skills associated within the game through First Tee Nine Core Values.
- First Tee of Greater Pasadena has introduced golf to over 1,587 youth through the TARGET Outreach programs.

First Tee Community Programs

- Specifically designed for youth-serving organizations, like the Y and the Boys & Girls Club, First Tee DRIVE gives kids the chance to learn about golf and develop character through fun golf games.

First Tee School Program

- Provides a tremendous value to the overall school-wide curriculum because of its emphasis on character education, fitness and because golf is a lifelong activity.
- Provides a complete golf program appropriate for today's elementary schools physical education students and teachers.
- First Tee - Greater Pasadena has served over 12,067 Pasadena Unified School District students in the First Tee School Program since 2009.
