Twenty years ago, a simple but meaningful idea took shape at Brookside Golf Course: to introduce more young people to the game of golf and use it as a platform to teach life skills that extend far beyond the course. In the summer of 2006, we welcomed our first 66 participants into what would become First Tee – Greater Pasadena. At the time, we relied on the generosity of local men’s and women’s club members to serve as our first coaches, helping us build a program rooted in purpose from day one.

What began as a single program in Pasadena quickly grew into something much greater. As interest expanded, so did our reach, first into nearby courses like Altadena and Eaton Canyon, and then throughout the region, including Arroyo Seco Golf Course, Marshall Canyon Golf Course, Santa Anita Golf Course, Alhambra Golf Course, and Mountain Meadows Golf Course. Along the way, we built a dedicated Board of Directors and formed partnerships with organizations that share our commitment to access and inclusion, including the YMCA, Pasadena Unified School District, Boys & Girls Club, Wounded Warrior Project, Special Olympics, Running Waters Day Program, City of Pasadena Recreation Department, City of Pasadena Police Department, AbilityFirst, Villa Esperanza, and the Latina Golfers Association.

Our approach has always been rooted in more than just golf. Through First Tee’s nine core values: Honesty, Integrity, Sportsmanship, Respect, Confidence, Responsibility, Perseverance, Courtesy, and Judgment, we aim to equip young people with the tools they need to succeed in school, in their relationships, and in life. Whether through after-school programs, summer camps, or opportunities to participate in tournaments and leadership conferences, we are proud to create pathways for growth both on and off the course.

Over the past two decades, we’ve been fortunate to receive tremendous support from the First Tee national organization, the Rose Bowl Operating Company, and the City of Pasadena, among many others. The City of Pasadena’s designation of October as First Tee Month reflects the impact this program has had across our region. We are also proud to be the only First Tee chapter in the United States with established international relationships, welcoming First Tee Korea to Pasadena to connect with our participants and community leaders.

As we celebrate this 20-year milestone, we do so with deep gratitude for the supporters, partners, coaches, volunteers, and families who have made this journey possible. Your belief in our mission has allowed us to reach thousands of young people and create opportunities that truly change lives.

Looking ahead, we are energized by what’s to come. We see continued growth across our service areas, expanded access to our programs, and deeper partnerships with the corporate and community leaders who share our vision. Most importantly, we remain committed to ensuring that every young person who participates in our programs leaves with greater confidence, stronger character, and a strong sense of possibility for their future.

Harvey Hyde is a longtime football coach, broadcaster, and sports commentator with more than six decades of experience in collegiate athletics. A Pasadena native, he attended Pasadena High School and Pasadena City College before earning both his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Redlands.

Hyde began his coaching career at the high school and junior college levels before serving as an assistant coach at the University of Hawaii and later leading his alma mater, Pasadena City College, to a successful 25-7 record and multiple conference championships from 1979 to 1981. He went on to serve as head football coach at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV), where he guided the Rebels to an 11-win season, a conference championship, and a California Bowl victory in 1984. Throughout his coaching career, Hyde mentored numerous standout athletes and coaches and became widely respected for his passion, leadership, and knowledge of the game.

Following his coaching career, Hyde transitioned into sports broadcasting and has become a trusted voice in college football, particularly covering USC athletics. Through radio, podcasts, public speaking engagements, and his website, HarveyHyde.com, he continues to share his insights and enthusiasm for the sport with audiences throughout Southern California and beyond.

HONOREE BIO

Bob Baderian is a lifelong Pasadena resident and youth development advocate who has dedicated more than three decades to serving the local community through recreation, sports, and mentorship. A graduate of California State University, Los Angeles, Bob spent much of his career with the City of Pasadena's Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department, serving in leadership roles including Parks and Natural Resources Director, where he helped advance initiatives that expanded access to parks, recreation, and youth programming throughout the city.

In 2005, Bob partnered with Darryl Dunn and David Sams to explore the feasibility of bringing First Tee to Pasadena, with the goal of introducing more young people to the game of golf while teaching life-enhancing values and skills. First Tee – Greater Pasadena launched its inaugural summer program at Brookside Golf Course in 2006 with 82 participants and a dedicated team of volunteers from local men's and women's golf clubs. As Executive Director and Co-Founder, Bob has helped grow the chapter from a single-site program into a regional organization serving more than 5,000 youth annually, with programming extending to Altadena, Eaton Canyon, South Pasadena, Arroyo Seco, Alhambra, schools, and community centers throughout the San Gabriel Valley.

Under Bob's leadership, the chapter has built meaningful partnerships with organizations including the YMCA, Boys & Girls Club, AbilityFirst, Villa Esperanza, Wounded Warrior Project, Running Waters, Special Olympics, and the Latino Golf Association, creating opportunities for youth and adaptive golfers alike. He is especially proud of the chapter's commitment to teaching First Tee's nine core values and life skills, helping participants develop confidence, accountability, perseverance, and sportsmanship on and off the course. Students have gone on to attend national academies, leadership conferences, and tournaments, while the City of Pasadena annually recognizes October as First Tee Month in honor of the program's impact.

Bob remains focused on expanding access to First Tee programming, strengthening community partnerships, increasing corporate support, and ensuring that even more young people have the opportunity to grow through golf and the lessons that extend far beyond the game.

Originally from Hanover, Pennsylvania, Mark earned a bachelor's degree in Sport Administration from Lock Haven University and gained experience working with First Tee chapters in Philadelphia and Southern Nevada before joining First Tee – Greater Pasadena on January 3, 2008.

Today, Mark oversees programming, daily operations, coaching, grant writing, and the chapter's annual golf tournament, helping ensure participants have access to meaningful opportunities both on and off the course.

Throughout his tenure, he has taken great pride in watching the chapter grow from a small, single-site program into a thriving organization serving thousands of young people across multiple communities. He is especially proud of the chapter's ability to adapt and support the community during times of challenge, including becoming one of the first chapters to offer organized programming during the COVID-19 pandemic and successfully relocating more than 70 percent of participants impacted by the Eaton Fire.

Mark values the strong partnerships the chapter has developed throughout the San Gabriel Valley and is passionate about creating experiences that extend beyond the golf course, providing participants with opportunities to build confidence, resilience, leadership skills, and character through coaching, mentorship, and national opportunities. HONOREE BIO

David Sams has spent more than five decades in the golf industry, dedicating his career to municipal golf operations, youth development, and expanding access to the game. His introduction to golf came unexpectedly as a teenager after stumbling upon a golf course at Edwards Air Force Base while riding his bicycle and being offered his very first job. That chance encounter sparked a lifelong passion for the game and a career devoted to helping others discover its many benefits.

After moving to Southern California, David joined Brookside Golf Course, where he worked his way up through the ranks to become Director of Golf. He played a key role in transitioning Brookside's operations from the City of Pasadena to American Golf in 1986, helping transform the facility into a successful public-private partnership. Throughout his career, David has advised municipalities and golf facilities on golf operations and management, while remaining closely connected to Brookside and the Rose Bowl.

In 2004, while pursuing a fee increase for Brookside Golf Course, Pasadena City Councilmember Joyce Streeter challenged golf leaders to create a meaningful youth golf program. Inspired by his own experiences in junior golf and recognizing the impact the game had on his life, David explored several youth development models before helping establish First Tee – Greater Pasadena in 2005 alongside Darryl Dunn, Bob Baderian, and community partners. He was instrumental in forming the chapter's original nonprofit organization and recruiting Bob Baderian to help launch and lead the chapter, which welcomed its first participants in 2006.

Today, David remains a proud advisor and champion for First Tee – Greater Pasadena. He credits the chapter's success to its perseverance, the dedication of its staff and volunteers, and its ability to positively impact the lives of thousands of young people over the past two decades. Looking back, David is most proud that what began as a simple commitment to introduce more youth to golf has grown into a thriving organization that continues to teach character, life skills, and confidence through the game he has loved since childhood.

HONOREE BIO

Darryl Dunn is a longtime sports executive whose career has spanned professional sports, international events, and one of the world's most iconic venues. A Connecticut native, Darryl earned a degree in Journalism from Saint Bonaventure University before relocating to Southern California to pursue a career in sports. Over the years, he held positions with the Los Angeles Kings, Los Angeles Raiders, Los Angeles Clippers, and the organizing committee for the 1994 FIFA World Cup before joining the Rose Bowl Operating Company in 1996. He served as Chief Executive Officer and General Manager of the Rose Bowl Stadium from 1999 until his retirement in 2022, overseeing all aspects of the organization and helping transform the Rose Bowl campus into one of the nation's premier sports and entertainment destinations.

During his 27-year tenure at the Rose Bowl, Darryl guided the stadium through historic milestones, including a \$183 million renovation, the negotiation of long-term agreements with

UCLA and the Tournament of Roses, the creation of the Rose Bowl Legacy Foundation, and the hosting of world-class sporting events, concerts, and international soccer matches. In recognition of his contributions, he was inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame in 2022.

Darryl also played an instrumental role in founding First Tee – Greater Pasadena. In 2004, while exploring ways to expand youth access to golf at Brookside Golf Course, he partnered with David Sams, Bob Baderian, and community leaders to establish the chapter. What began as a response to a community need has grown into a thriving organization that has positively impacted thousands of young people throughout the San Gabriel Valley. Darryl remains proud of First Tee – Greater Pasadena's growth over the past two decades and the opportunities it continues to provide young people to build confidence, character, and life skills through the game of golf.



- **2006**

First Tee – Greater Pasadena launched, serving 82 participants in its inaugural summer program at Brookside Golf Course.

- **2009**

Reached more than 1,000 participants served.

Evan Davis became the chapter's first participant selected to compete at Pebble Beach.

- **2016**

Celebrated the chapter's 10th Anniversary and launched a partnership with Special Olympics.

Expanded programming to Marshall Canyon Golf Course.

- **2023**

Expanded to Mountain Meadows Golf Course, launched the Running Water Day Program, and began a partnership with PGA TOUR Superstore.

- **2025**

Reached nine program locations and relocated 70% of winter participants to three new sites following the Eaton Fire.

- **2008**

Hosted the First Annual Golf Invitational and expanded programming to Altadena and Eaton Canyon Golf Courses.

Partnered with Pasadena Parks, Recreation and Community Services to offer summer programming.

- **2011**

Implemented the National School Program in partnership with Pasadena Unified School District.

- **2015**

Partnered with the Northern Trust Open at Riviera Country Club. Three participants met Anthony Kim.

- **2018**

Established partnerships with the Wounded Warrior Project and the Latina Golfers Association.

- **2020**

Became one of the first Pasadena organizations to resume organized youth programming during COVID-19.

- **2024**

Served more than 2,000 youth through Life Skills Experience classes.
